NOTICE INVITING QUOTATION

Sealed quotations are hereby invited from approved and eligible electrical contractors of CPWD, Railway, MES, BSNL, MCD, DDA, NDMC, Delhi Jal Board, I&F Deptt. Delhi, Delhi State PWD on behalf of DUSIB for the under mentioned work. The unregistered contractors can also apply provided they also submit the required documents.

The contractor shall submit the following attested documents along with application in the Office of the Executive Engineer(E-3).

- i) Copy of GSTIN Number as issued by GST department.
- ii) Copy of valid registration certificate of the department registered with (In case of registered contractors).
- iii) Copy of PAN card issued by income tax department.
- iv) Copy of Electrical Contractor license.

The quotation should reach this office on 17.01.2018 by 3:00 PM which shall be opened on the same day at 03:30 PM in the presence of the participating contractors or their representatives whosoever wish to be present in the office.

The firms who wish to participate in the quotation shall submit their application along with the above documents for issue of prescribed NIQ format on or before 15.01.2018 by 03:00 PM. The prescribed NIQ format, detail description of the item, detailed specifications of the quotations can be obtained from this office on or before 15.01.2018 upto 03:00 AM.

Name of Work: Construction and management of Night Shelter.

Sub Head: Providing, erection, testing & commissioning of semi high mast (Hot dipped galvanized octagonal pole) at Jama Masjid, Mori Gate and Yamuna Pusta Night Shelters.

Estimated cost: Rs. 6,10555/-

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The work should be completed within 15 days after the date of receipt of the work order.
2. No extra charges shall be paid. *Work must be done as per CPWD specs -*
3. Rates should be quoted for the work as above & site.
4. Conditional quotations shall not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.
5. The materials should be only as per specifications, duly approved by site in charge, before use.
6. T&P shall be borne by the agency.
7. Drinking water arrangement shall be made by agency for labour working at site at his own cost.
8. For any type of accident, mishaps during execution of work at site shall be sole responsibility of the agency and department shall not be in any case be responsible and liable for such type of accident or mishap.
9. Quotation received after the due date and time will not be considered.
10. Payment shall be made by RTGS.
11. No out of station quotation shall be entertained and accepted.
12. The E.E(E-3) has the right to reject or accept the quotation.
13. All the scraps and surplus material shall be removed from the site.
14. All the rejected, un approved material should be removed from the site.
15. Sub standard work shall be liable in not release of payment for that article and the agency will be blacklisted, debarred for misleading the department.
16. The Watch & Ward, storage of the material shall be the responsibility of the work executing agency.
17. The firms shall have to submit the attested copy of above certificates which shall be valid on the date of receipt of application.
18. Quotation in sealed cover for items only prescribed NIQ format issued by the office shall only be accepted. Any quotation other than the prescribed NIQ format issued by this office shall not be entertained.
19. The deduction of Security@2.5%, Income Tax & Labour cess shall be deducted from the gross amount of the bill as per rules.
20. If any component, in addition to mentioned scope of work, is required for meeting prescribed effluent parameters, the contractor shall provide same without claiming any extra payment.
21. Intending bidders are advised to see the site conditions before quoting the rates.
